CalAIM | ECM & Community Supports

Enhanced Care Management (ECM)

- ECM is statewide MCP benefit
- Provides person-centered, community-based care management to the highest need members
- DHCS and MCPs began implementing ECM in phases by Populations of Focus (POFs)
- Service includes assignment of Lead Care Manager

Community Supports (CS)

- Community Supports are services that address members' health-related social needs
- Also called “In Lieu of Services” (ILOS)
- And help them avoid higher, costlier levels of care
- Currently not all MCPs offer all 15 Community Supports Services in all counties they serve (though strongly encouraged by DHCS)

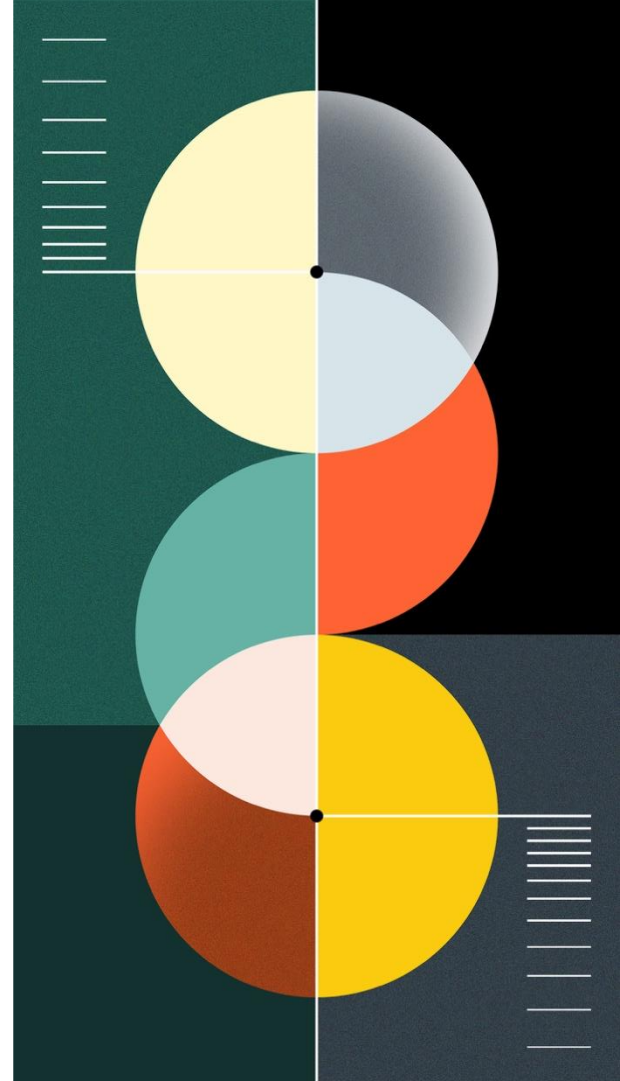

San Diego CPI 2025 Aim Statement

By **December 31st, 2025**, the **San Diego County PATH CPI Collaborative** will **increase access of eligible beneficiaries to ECM and Community Supports** by:

- 1. Enhanced Care Management** – Increasing enrollment of eligible members of ECM to **40,000 beneficiaries (roughly 40% increase in total number of individuals)** from Q4 2024 to December 31, 2025.
- 2. Community Supports** – Increasing Community Support utilization of eligible members to **18,000 services provided (65% increase)** from Q4 2024 to December 31, 2025.

Contra Costa CPI 2025 Aim Statement

By **December 31st, 2025**, the **Contra Costa County PATH CPI Collaborative** will **facilitate engagement between providers of Medi-Cal services and MCPs** to improve Medi-Cal standards, systems, and processes which will:

- 1. Increase enrollment of eligible members in Enhanced Care Management to 9,500 members enrolled (60% increase over Q3 2024)**
- 2. Increase Community Supports utilization of eligible members to 4,500 services provided (33% increase over Q3 2024)**
